ORDER FOR ADOPTION OF BOND SCHEDULE

THIS COURT, having reviewed the past bond schedule, does hereby find that the bond schedule needs to be updated;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THIS COURT that the attached bond schedule dated the 17th day of June, 2011 be and the same time is hereby adopted, and shall become effective July 1st, 2011.

Unless a specific bail amount appears in the body of this schedule, the amount of bail is:

A = \$ 55.00
B = \$ 70.00
C = \$120.00
D = \$220.00
E = \$420.00

Any offense not listed on this schedule is a “must appear”.

If the “MAY FORFEIT BOND IN LIEU OF APPEARANCE” box is checked, the person has two options:

1. APPEAR ON THE DAY AND AT THE TIME SPECIFIED ON THE CITATION
OR
2. POST BOND AT OR PRIOR TO THE COURT DATE AND FORFEIT THE SAME
IN LIEU OF APPEARANCE

A person to whom a citation has been issued **MUST APPEAR** in court on the day and at the time specified on the citation **UNLESS** the citing officer checks the box “MAY FORFEIT BOND IN LIEU OF APPEARANCE” on the citation.

Drivers accused of a traffic offense are not required to post an appearance bond **IF** the licensing state is a compact member (AL, AR, AZ, CO, CN, DE, DC, FL, GA, HA, ID, IL, IN, IA, KS, KY, LA, MA, MD, ME, MN, MO, MS, NE, NV, NH, NJ, NM, NY, NC, ND, OH, OK, PA, RI, SC, SD, TN, TX, UT, VT, VI, WA, WV, WY). An officer may require an appearance bond be posted for licenses issued by AK, CA, MI, MT, OR, WI and shall require posting of an appearance bond for all licenses issued from a foreign country.

If an officer has reason to doubt the accused (any offense) will appear as promised, the officer may require posting of an appearance bond. If a bond is not listed in the schedule, the appearance bond shall be \$210.00.

Appearance bonds shall be paid in cash or money order only.

Seat belt reduction - Wyo. Stat. Ann. 31-5-14-2(e)(2000 amendment) provides that “All citations for violations of the motor vehicle laws of this state shall contain a notation by the issuing officer indicating whether the driver and passenger(s) complied with this section.” Compliance with this section shall entitle a licensee to a ten dollar (\$10.00) reduction in the fine otherwise imposed. “ The Wyoming Supreme Court ruled that it applies to both bail and fines.
