

## CLAUDE EDWARD ADAMS

Services for Claude Edward Adams will be held Friday, Sept. 10, 1982 at 10:30 a.m. at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Rev. Dan Barcus officiating. Mr. Adams died Sept. 6, 1982 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Home. Adams was born December 12, 1893 in Dwyer on the land homesteaded by his parents, George and Ida Adams. He was raised and educated in the area. On April 10, 1919, he and Grace Johnson were married. They raised their family of ten on the family homestead on Cottonwood Creek.

Adams served as County Commissioner, and for years as a 4-H leader. He was a member of IOOF receiving his 50-year pin in August of 1979. He was a Past Master of the Cottonwood Grange and Past President of the Laramie Peak Rock Club. Survivors include, besides his widow Grace, three sons: Jim Adams of Claypool, AZ, Ray Adams of Michigan, Bob Adams of Lander, five daughters Ruth Miller of Riverton, Ida Robertson of Baltimore, MD, Twyla Parlett of Casper, Ruby Stones of Sabetha, Kansas, Georgia Butler of Lillington, N.C. and one sister Bertha Adams of Casper. He was preceded in death by a daughter, Edith, by a son Bill and by one sister Florence. Burial will be in the Wheatland Cemetary.
