January 29, 1875-October 28, 1956

A retired farmer of Chugwater, Philip Ash passed away October 28 at his home following an extended illness. Services were held Wednesday at 2 p.m. at the Methodist church with the Rev. Charles W. Roberts, Jr. and Rev. J.B. Milstead conducting.

Mr. Ash was born January 29, 1875 to Edmund Ash and Elmira Snyder at Bedford county, Pa. and was 81 at the time of his death. He had made his home in Chugwater since 1913 and prior to that in North Dakota.
