

**CAMPBELL, CHARLES WILLIAM**  
1889-June 25, 1950

Charles William Campbell, a former resident of Slater, died suddenly Sunday afternoon at his home in Cheyenne, 1502 E. 20<sup>th</sup> street. He had lived in Cheyenne the past two years.
