

CAMPBELL, NEWTON BUSBY  
December 26, 1870-March 4, 1952

Services will be held Sunday in the Baptist church for Newton B. Campbell, at 2 o'clock, with Rev. Charles Thomas and Rev. Henry Frost officiating.

Mr. Campbell was born in Grinnell, Iowa December 26, 1870, and died at his home March 4, 1952, following an extended illness, at the age of 81.

He was a retired farmer and had lived in Platte county since 1910.
