

Angelina Rose "Angie" Cancino

Funeral Liturgy for Angelina Rose "Angie" Cancino, 86, will be held Wednesday, Dec. 12, at 10 a.m. at Saint Patrick Catholic Church in Wheatland, with Father Jan Santich as Celebrant. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Cancino died Dec. 8, at Mountain Towers Healthcare in Cheyenne.

Angie was a foster mother for 278 children. She was a member of the Altar Rosary Society, Women of the Moose, and Saint Patrick Catholic Church. She enjoyed cooking, crocheting and ceramics.
