

CARBERRY, OLIVE LORRAINE BAKER

December 1, 1931-October 7, 1965

Last rites for Olive Lorraine Carberry, a Wheatland resident since 1945, were held at the Schrader Chapel, Oct. 9, 1965, at 2:00 p.m. Services were conducted by Mr. Dale Scheffler with interment in the Wheatland cemetery.
