Services for Cora Alice Carey, 79, who died March 5, 1988, in Cheyenne, were held in the First Christian Church in Wheatland Tuesday, March 8, 1988, at 2 p.m. with Pastor Dan Barcus officiating.

Born in Golry, Okla., Jan. 2, 1909, the daughter of Charles and Mary (Boehm) Carter. At the age of eight she moved with her family to a homestead near Slater. She was reared and educated in Slater.
