

CARLSON, FRED OSCAR
May 4, 1879-April 19, 1956

Fred Oscar Carlson, 77, resident of Wheatland for 33 years and Platte county resident for 46 years, succumbed last Thursday, April 19, at the Platte Memorial hospital after a short illness.

The deceased was born in Sweden May 4, 1878, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Carl Carlson. He was a railroad worker for many years, being retired at the time of his death. He was a member of the Trinity Lutheran church.

Funeral services were held at the Schrader chapel at 2 p.m., Saturday, April 21, the Rev. Oscar Marquardt conducting the rites, with burial in the Wheatland cemetery.
