

CARLSON, JACK TILDON
August 14, 1938-June 8, 1988

Memorial services of Jack Tildon Carlson, 49, of Pendleton, Ore. and formerly of the Yoder area, will be held at 2 p.m. Friday at the Seventh Day Adventist Church in Torrington, with Pastor Stan Patterson officiating.

Mr. Carlson died June 8, 1988, in Pendleton.

He was born Aug. 14, 1938, at Wheatland, the son of Carl and Leva (Rutherford) Carlson. He grew up on the family wheat farm near Yoder and attended school in Yoder. Mr. Carlson served in the United States Navy during the Korean Conflict and in Vietnam. He also served in the Merchant Marines for two years.

On Oct. 31, 1981, he married Terri Ann Kraft in Douglas. Prior to moving with his family Pendleton in 1985. Mr. Carlson was employed by the Exxon mines and Texas Gulf mines for 15 years. He was employed at the Harris pine mills in Pendleton for three years.

He became a member of the Seventh Day Adventist Church in February 1988.

Survivors include his wife, and daughters Dayle, Jody, Bobbi, and Rebel, all of Pendleton; his mother of Yoder; three brothers, George Carlson of Loving, N.M., Carl Carlson of Yoder, and Chuck Carlson of Hallsville, Mo.; and two sisters, Illa Mae valentine of Oldtown, Fla., and Kathy Parsons of Powell.

Mr. Carlson was preceded in death by his father.

Cremation has taken place. Memorials have been established to the Seventh Day Adventist Church in Torrington and to the family.
