

CARMICHAEL, DEWEY STANLEY

May 9, 1898-May 27, 1952

Last rites will be held for Dewey Stanley Carmichael, 54, Saturday, May 31, at 2:00 p.m. at the Schrader Chapel.

Mr. Carmichael was born May 9, 1898, in Wheatland, and died in Worland May 27. He had been accidentally injured when a horse fell with him.

He had been a resident of Ten Sleep, Wyo. for the past several years. He left Wheatland in the early '20's and went to Casper with the American Railway Express Company, after which he went to Ten Sleep where he worked on the Holland Brothers ranch near there.

He is survived by three sisters: Mrs. Laura Atkins of Denver, Colorado, Mrs. Mayme Agnew of Los Angeles, California, and Mrs. Maude Ransom of Sumner, Washington.

His body was returned to Wheatland Thursday and burial will be made in the Wheatland cemetery.
