

## **Elizabeth "Betty" Mae Moxley**

Funeral services for Elizabeth "Betty Mae Moxley, 88 will be held at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, July 23, 2003 at the Wheatland Bible Church with Pastor Denzil G Mauk officiating. Inurnment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Betty died Saturday July 19, 2003 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.
