

CARMICHAEL, LOVERNIA JANE BOWEN

December 26, 1855-March 3, 1934

Mrs. Lovenia Jane Carmichael, one of the pioneer ranch women of Platte county, passed away at the home of her son Wednesday. Mrs. Carmichael had not been well for the past ten days and last week was removed from her home 12 miles northwest of here to Wheatland. Her condition showed quite remarked improvement up until Wednesday morning at which time she had an acute heart attack to which she succumbed in a few minutes.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Methodist church. Interment will be made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Copley Funeral Home in charge.

The deceased was born at Benton, Iowa, December 26th, 1854. She came to this country about 45 years ago. She is survived by eleven children; Thos. L., Sedwick, Canada; Mrs. George Phillips, Oakland, Ore.; Orin A. of Idaho; Mrs. Wm. Landerson, Madesto, Calif.; Mrs. Laura Adkins, Denver; George of California; Mrs. Frank Agnew, Mrs. Chas. Hanson, Mrs. Frank Ranson of Washington state; Dewey of Casper and Bert of Wheatland. Her husband preceded her in death about 35 years ago.
