

CARSON, DORA  
February 18, 1889-March 17, 1966

Services for Mrs. Dora Carson were held in the Schrader Chapel on March 21 at 10:00 a.m. with Rev. Henry Hartberg officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mrs. Carson was born in London, England on Feb. 18, 1889. She was married in England and then moved to Canada, then to Tennessee, and from there to the Wheatland area. She was well-known here for the hundreds of dolls she repaired and dressed for the Lander Home.

Death occurred in the Platte County Memorial Hospital on Mar. 17, 1966, following a lengthy illness. Mrs. Carson was a member of the Southern Baptist Church.

Relatives surviving are her daughter, Iris Carson of Wheatland and a sister still living in England. Casketbearers included R.E. Berg, Joe Johnson, Phil Rietz, and Roscoe Comstock.
