

CASTER, WARREN VIRGIL  
September 20, 1886-June 11, 1937

The community of Cassa and Glendo were shocked to learn that Warren Caster, brother of Russ Caster, of Cassa, had hanged himself in the barn on his brother's place about ten o'clock Friday morning. Mr. Caster had recently come to Wyoming from Brush, Colo., in hope that the change would improve his health. He slept in the bunkhouse Thursday night, and the family did not call him for breakfast Friday morning, but thought they would let him sleep as late as he wished. When Caster did not appear, Russ investigated and found that Warren had hanged himself from a beam in the barn. Sheriff Joe Wickam and Coroner Stewart Dennis were called from Wheatland and after investigating the case, declared that an inquest was not necessary.

Warren Virgil Caster was born in Jewell county, Kansas, September 20, 1886, and was 50 years of age at his death.

Funeral services were held Sunday, June 13<sup>th</sup>, at the Watson and Dennis Funeral Home, with Rev. J.L. Williams officiating. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
