

# Larry Chapin

Funeral services for Larry Dean Chapin, 36, of Wheatland were held Friday, Feb. 23, 1979, at the Church of the Nazarene with the Rev. Charles Jacques officiating.

Chapin was born Oct. 22, 1942 in Washington. As a young man, he traveled the country extensively, working at many different occupations. He came to the Wheatland area six years ago and met and married Hazel Bowdish here.

He worked for some time for Bookout Appliance as a service man and was also employed by American Plumbing and Heating in Wheatland. Just prior to his illness, he accepted the position of surveyor with the Wyoming Highway Department based here in Wheatland.
