

CHASE, ARTHUR ADELBERT  
February 4, 1881-January 5, 1962

Funeral services were held for Arthur Adelbert Chase, 80, Monday, Jan. 8, at 2 p.m. at the Schrader Chapel, with the Rev. Robert French officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery with graveside services conducted by the Rock Lake Grange.

Pallbearers were Orvel Bridgmon, S.R. Mills, Franzel Memmer, Frank Franzen, Lester Jones and Paul Hartley.

Mr. Chase was born Feb. 4, 1881 in Tama county, Iowa, and had been a resident of the Wheatland community since 1903. He died at the Platte County Memorial hospital Jan. 5 following an extended illness. He was the son of Charles F. Chase and Emma Wear. On April 9, 1907 Mr. Chase was united in marriage to Miss Katheryn Kenty in the Congregational church parsonage in Wheatland. They were the parents of three sons, Richard L., Charles C., and Leo N.

The deceased was a member of the Rock Lake Grange. He will be remembered as a kindly person and a thoughtful neighbor by the residents of the South Flats community where the family resided for many years on their farm. After retiring from farming, Mr. and Mrs. Chase moved into Wheatland.

Left to mourn his passing are his wife, Katheryn, Wheatland; three sons, Richard L., and Leo N., of Wheatland and Charles C. of Laramie; two brothers, James E. Chase, Wheatland and W.F. Chase, Grants Pass, Ore.; one sister, Mrs. Florence Willcuts, Long Beach, Calif.; three grandchildren and one great grandchild.
