KATHERYN LOUISE CHASE

Services for Katheryn Louise Chase, 96, who died Aug. 16, in the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Wing were held Thursday, Aug. 18, at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with the Rev. Virgil Lamm officiating.

Katheryn Chase was born in Rawlins, April 9, 1887, the daughter of Daniel and Emiline Carrol Kenty. At the age of 10 she moved by covered wagon from Rawlins to Wheatland, a one day trip. She attended school at the Keas School.

She and Arthur Chase were married on April 9, 1907. The couple farmed southwest of Wheatland until their retirement in 1956 when they moved into Wheatland.

She was a charter member of Rock Lake Grange, becoming a member Aug. 15, 1913, and she was a former member of the Pleasant Hour Club and the Grandmother's Club of Wheatland.

Survivors include three sons: Richard Chase of Wheatland, Leo Chase of Jackson; Charles Chase, Laramie; two brothers: Roy D. Kenty of Rialto, Cal., William H. Kenty of Hemet, Cal., three grandsons and seven great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Arthur, in 1962, by her parents and four sisters.
