## Edna H. Clark 1981

Services were held Tuesday at the First Christian Church for Edna Hill Clark, 94, who died Oct. 8, 1981 at Austin, Texas, following an extended illness.

Born Oct. 9, 1888 in Warren County, Iowa, the daughter of Henry and Josephine Hill, she moved to Decatur, Iowa, with her parents at an early age. In 1907 she was married to John W. She was preceded in death by her husband, John; a daughter, Josephine, and infant sons, Clarence and Raymond.
