Funeral services were held today (Thursday) at 2 p.m. at the Schrader chapel for Mrs. Lenora Judge Clark, 71, of Jewell, Kans., mother of Mrs. Robert Straw of Wheatland. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery with services in charge of Rev. Lester L. Mengel. Mrs. Clark passed away April 29 at the Community hospital in Beloit, Kans. after an extended illness.
