## Lloyd Everett Clemetson

Lloyd Evercit Clemetson, 62, of 1456 Cole Street, died Sunday at the Platte Co. Memorial Hospital.

Born May 19, 1925 in Comertown, Mont., he was the son of Oscar and Olga (Olson) Clemetson. He had lived in Wheatland since 1973.

After graduating from Comertown High School, he was engaged in farming and ranching operations. He served in the army stationed in Alaska during the Korean conflict.

Clemetson was graduated from North Dakota State School of Science and North Dakota State University with degrees in Mechanized Agriculture and Ag. Education. He taught for several years in Minnesota and North Dakota before moving to Wyoming where he owned and operated Laramie Peak Feed Company before going to work for Basin Electric as a water treatment operator in 1978.

He was preceded in death by his parents and sister Ardith Ayers.
