

# Albert L. Cobb

January 20, 1917 – February 10, 2007

Albert L. Cobb, 90, of Topeka, Kan., went to be with His Lord on Saturday, Feb. 10, 2007.

Al was the youngest son of J. Albert and Adeline (McClelland) Cobb, born Jan. 20, 1917, in Vermillion, S.D. He married Phyllis M. Norris on Aug. 28, 1938, in Wheatland. Al served in the United States Army Air Corps during World War II, serving in Cuba and on Okinawa, Japan.

Mr. Cobb graduated from Westmont College, Santa Barbara, Calif., earning a bachelor's degree in psychology in 1953, and a master's degree in 1970. Al worked at Los Prietos Boy's Camp in Santa Barbara as a group supervisor, counselor, senior group counselor, and placement officer, counseling teenage boys in a live-in situation, until his retirement in 1983.

Upon retirement in 1983, he and Phyllis moved to

Topeka, Kans. Al was preceded in death by his father, J. Albert Cobb; his mother, Adeline (McClelland) Cobb; his sister, Mary Grace Moss; and his three brothers, Lester, John and Walter. Al is survived by his wife Phyllis, of the home; son Ronald and his wife Kathleen of Holton, Kans.; two grandchildren, David and Elizabeth; and three great-grandsons.

Mr. Cobb was a member of the Topeka Bible Church, where memorial services were held on Wednesday, Feb. 14, at 10:30 a.m., officiated by Rev. Jim Congdon.
