

COCHRAN, STELLA ADA JACKSON  
October 2, 1891-December 12, 1965

An extended illness claimed the life of Stella Ada Cochran at the DePaul hospital in Cheyenne on Dec. 12, 1965. Mrs. Cochran was born in Troy Grove, Ill. on Oct. 2, 1891 and resided in Modale, Ia. prior to moving to the Wheatland area in 1919. She was a member of the Methodist church, Rebekah Lodge, WCWC and OES.

She was preceded in death by her first husband, Ryland B. Logan in 1938. Her second husband, Homer W. Cochran succumbed in 1958.
