

COCHRANE FAMILY HISTORY

Corrections to obituaries: David Cochrane (age 90 at death) owned what came to be known as the Cuba Ranch, up Palmer Canyon Road, in Albany County. He owned this ranch for several years, marry Agnes McFarlane and having one son. Agnes was the youngest daughter of David and Jenet McFarlane, Sr. Agnes lived with her parents on the M Bar ranch from 1874 to 1882, when the McFarlanes (the women, anyway) all moved to Cheyenne because of the constant trouble with Indians. David Cochrane never lived in the Chugwater area. There are many stories of him in the Rock Creek area before he settled down and married Agnes. David and Agnes sold their Owen, WY ranch to Noel Hall and moved to Sand Creek, before finally moving into the town of Wheatland in 1910. Aggie paid to have her parents' graves and William Oliver's grave, who was also buried up in the mountain cemetery (known as the McFarlane Oliver cemetery) moved to the Wheatland Cemetery. As far as we know, the headstones were the ones originally installed at the mountain cemetery.
