

COLBY, CHARLES R.

1889-April 5, 1941

Charles R. Colby, a resident of Guernsey since 1914, died last Saturday in Chicago, Ill., following an illness of two years. He was fifty-one years of age at the time of his death.

Surviving him are two sisters and three brothers. One sister, Mrs. Thomas Tucker and one brother, Ed Colby, make their home in Guernsey.

Services were conducted Tuesday afternoon from the Community church of Guernsey with the Rev. Joseph Kamphius in charge. Military services were held at the grave in the Hartville cemetery (later reinterred in Wheatland) for Mr. Colby, who was a World War veteran. Members of the Wheatland, Hartville and Sunrise Legions attended the services. The bugle call was played by Gene Perkins.
