Edward J. Colby, of Guernsey, died suddenly at Denver Christmas Day from a heart attack, at the age of 65.

He was a retired farmer and had made his home in Platte County for 35 years, coming here from Chicago. He was a member VFW, having served in the Spanish-American War.
