

COLEMAN, MILLARD FILLMORE
September 15, 1859-December 29, 1930

News of the death of M.F. Coleman, pioneer ranchman of the Cottonwood section, 20 miles north of Wheatland, was received with regret by the many friends of the members of the family throughout this section of the state. Mr. Coleman had been in failing health for a number of years and had passed away at the family home in Lander on Tuesday morning.

Mr. Coleman was one of the early settlers of old Laramie county, taking up the homestead on Cottonwood creek which was the family home for many years. He moved to Lander something over ten years ago and has since resided at that place.

Mr. Coleman was one of the prominent residents of Platte county, and served in the capacity of county commissioner after the organization of Platte county.

The remains will be shipped to Wheatland for burial, and funeral services will be held on Friday afternoon at two o'clock at the Congregational church.
