January 1, 1911-December 23, 1978

Vivian Louise Coleman was born Jan. 1, 1911 at Lucerne, Wyo. to Thomas and Winnifred Shaffer. She died Dec. 23, 1978 in Wheatland after an extended illness.

She attended schools in Thermopolis and attended college at Colo. State Teachers College, in Greeley, Colo. and the University of Wyo. At Laramie. She taught schools in Hot Springs and Platte Counties in Wyoming and Keensburg, Colo.

She married Harry Coleman on Sept. 6, 1957 in Rapid City, So. Dak. She and her husband were engaged in cattle ranching for several years near Wheatland. She was preceded in death by her husband, Harry, her father, and her brother, Otis.

She is survived by her mother, Winnifred Shaffer of Thermopolis, two brothers, Ray Shaffer of Thermopolis and Cecil Shaffer of Fruita, Colo., two sisters, Viola Ryan of Wheatland and Gladys Yount of Casper. Surviving also are several nieces and nephews.
