

COLES, ADA WYMAN ROBINSON

May 4, 1883-April 5, 1958

Funeral services were held Tuesday, April 8, at 2:30 p.m. for Mrs. Ada Robinson Coles, former resident of this community. Rev. B.B. Byus conducted the last rites held in the Schrader chapel, with burial in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mrs. Coles was born May 4, 1883 and passed away April 5 in Casper following an extended illness. She had made her home in Worland for ten years prior to moving to Casper about eight months ago, and lived in this community for a number of years having homesteaded in the Fletcher Park area.
