

COMBS, ULYSSIS V.

1880-March 23, 1969

Ulyssis V. Combs' services were held Tues., Mar. 25 at 2:00 p.m. in the Schrader Chapel with Rev. Henry Hartberg officiating and interment in the Wheatland cemetery. He succumbed Mar. 23, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital after an extended illness.
