

COMSTOCK, ROSCO SPENCER
September 27, 1913-January 12, 1985

Funeral services for Rosco Comstock, 71, who died January 12th, in Wheatland, were held January 14, 1985 at 2:00 p.m. at St Patrick Catholic Church in Wheatland with Father Cletus Prado officiating.

Born in Peach Orchard, Arkansas, September 27, 1913, Rosco Spencer Comstock was the son of Robert and Eunice Comstock. He spent his childhood in Houston, Missouri. He and Gladys Daugherty were married in February of 1933. In 1948 they moved to Houston, Missouri for a year and then in 1949 moved to Douglas, Wyoming where they owned and operated Green T Service Station and he worked for the Police Department. In 1954 they moved to Wheatland where he ran a water well drilling business. In 1970 he went into the insurance business until ill health caused his retirement.

He was a Second Degree Knight in the Knights of Columbus and a twenty-six year member of the Moose Lodge.

Survivors include his wife Gladys Comstock of Wheatland, three sons, Robert and Charles, both of Wheatland, Gardner Comstock of Edmonds, Washington, Two daughters, Patricia Anderson of Guernsey, Sharon Comstock of Wheatland and seven grandchildren.

Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother and one grandchild.
