

Geo. Courtright Dies Monday In California

Funeral services for George C. Courtright, 88, of Supelveda, Calif., will be Saturday, July 8, 1972 at the Schrader Chapel at 10:30 a.m., with burial at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Courtright died Monday, July 3, 1972 in Van Nuys, Calif., after an extended illness. He was born on May 28, 1884 in Logan, Iowa, and was married to the former Eunice Pine Reed in 1908 in Corning, Iowa. Mr. Courtright resided in Wheatland between 1903 and 1907, and was a retired salesman. He lived in Iowa between 1907 and 1920, in North Platte, Neb., 1920-1934, in Alliance, Neb., 1934-1949, and in California from 1949 until his death. Mr. Courtright was a member of the Methodist

Church and the Masonic Lodge.

Mrs. Courtright preceded him in death on April 4, 1969. Survivors include one son, Gerald Courtright of Van Nuys, Calif., and one daughter, Mrs. Hal (Goldine) Driscoll, of Supelveda, Calif. He has two sisters: Mrs. H. C. Barger of Phoenix, Ariz., and Mrs. C. V. Bullock of Dalton, Nebr. One brother and one sister preceded him in death.
