November 26, 1859-April 7, 1940

Harry Cundal was born Nov. 26, 1859 at East Orten, Lincoln Shire, England and departed this life April 7, 1940 at Glendo, Wyo. at the age of 80 yearsm 4 months and 12 days.

He was the youngest of a family of 8 children, all of whom have preceeded him in death.

On October 15, 1884, he was united in marriage to Alice Ann Ratcliff who passed away March 2, 1937.
