

Mildred Carolyn 'Millie' Curtis

August 1, 1929 – May 30, 2010

A graveside service and inurnment for Mildred "Millie" Curtis, 80, will be conducted at 10:30 A.M., Thursday, June 3, 2010, in the Wheatland Cemetery in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Pastor Andy Gudahl of the First Christian Church officiating.

She died Sunday, May 30, 2010, at the Platte County Memorial Nursing Home in Wheatland.
