Funeral services for Mildred Pearl Cussins, age 90, were held at the Platte Funeral Chapel Wednesday, Jan. 3, at 10:30 a.m., with Andy Gudahl officiating. Mrs. Cussins died Friday, Dec. 29, at De Paul Hospital in Cheyenne.

Mildred Pearl Cussins was born April 19, 1899 to George and Cora (Large) Golding near Grant, Neb. In 1911 they moved to a farm near Stratton, Neb.

After finishing school, she helped her father on the farm, and at harvest time she always drove the header team.

On Nov. 19, 1925, she and Cecil Cussins were married in Stratton. After their marriage, they farmed in the Stratton area. In 1932, they moved to the Slater-Bordeaux community in Wyoming where they farmed.

In 1946, they moved and homesteaded a tract of land south of Wheatland.

She is survived by two daughters, Evelyn Yeadon of Wheatland, and Norma Phelps of Cheyenne; two sons, Leonard Cussins of Wheatland and Orville Cussins of Cheyenne; two sisters, Eva Elliott of Orange City, Calif., and Letha McGuire of Stratton, Neb.; 14 grandchildren and 22 great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, one sister, three grandsons and one granddaughter.
