

Stephanie Ebert, pioneer resident passes away Wed.

Mrs. Stephanie Ebert, long time resident of Wheatland, passed away in Platte County Memorial Hospital August 3, 1960. She had been ill for some time and hospitalized since July 6. She was a pioneer resident, having made her home here since 1896.
