

EDMISTON, SAMUEL NEWON
October 6, 1882-October 28, 1962

Samuel N. Esdmiston, born in Bethany, Mo. Oct. 6, 1882, died in the Wheatland hospital Oct. 28, following an extended illness. Mr. Edmiston, a retired farmer, had resided here since 1929.

His wife, Sarah Ann, preceded him in death in 1957. Survivors are three sons, Samuel E. Edmiston of Wheatland, Richard Edmiston of Boise, Ida. and Ivan Edmiston of Casper. Two sons preceded him in death.
