March 12, 1887-August 11, 1961

Marvin Francis Elliott, Guernsey, was born March 12, 1887, in Stoutland, Mo. and passed away suddenly at his home, Aug. 11.

Mr. Elliott was a retired section foreman, having worked for the CB & Q for 43 years. He had made his home in Guernsey since 1933. He was a veteran of World War I and was affiliated with the Baptist church.
