Death came quietly Wednesday to Herman Engles who was found dead about noon in a little cabin he called home in Mrs. Huntsinger's lots in the west part of town. Coroner Payne was immediately called and stated the old gentleman had been dead only a short time, heart trouble is believed the cause.

Mr. Engles was an old timer in this part of the country and could remember the day when he was one of the real huskies of this section, but for several years he has been crippled and unable to use his legs, yet in the eight or more years he has resided in the little cabin he has made his way about the room and to the open door where he enjoyed sitting when the weather permitted.

Mr. Engles was born November 8, 1859 in Chicago. He leaves a brother, Franklin Engles in Casper and a nephew east of Glendo. It is not known whether he was ever married.
