Funeral liturgy for Jessie Margaret English, 99, will be conducted at 10:00 A.M. Thursday, April 23, 2009, at Saint Patrick Catholic Church in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Father Jan Santich as Celebrant. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

She died Saturday, April 18, 2009, at Mountain Towers Healthcare Center in Cheyenne, Wyoming.

Jessie was born March 6, 1910, in Blaine County, Giles, Nebraska, the daughter of Albert John and Margaret (Featherstone) Fellows. She was reared and educated in Broken Bow, Nebraska, graduating from Broken Bow High School. Jessie married Frank Leslie English in Broken Bow on January 8, 1932. They moved to Wyoming in 1945 to farm south of Wheatland. Beginning in 1954, they owned and operated Capitol Ice & Storage and retired from that business in the early 1970's. Jessie trained to become a nurses' aide in the late 1970's. She enjoyed her family, yard sales, gardening, quilting and collecting dolls. Jessie was a member of Saint Patrick Catholic Church and Women of the Moose.

Survivors include her son, John J. (Beverly) English of Casper, Wyoming; two sisters, Alberta Jensen of Broken Bow and Emma Hughes of Grand Island, Nebraska; eight granddaughters, eight great grandchildren and two great great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents; husband Frank on February 4, 1974; three sons, Patrick English, Michael English, and William "Will" English; one sister; five brothers; and a grandson, Michael English, Jr.
