

Alfred Erlandson 1896 to 1996

Cremation for Alfred Erlandson, 99, were held and a private memorial service will be held at a later date.

Mr. Erlandson died Tuesday, Nov. 4 at Westward Heights Care Center in Lander, Wyo. Mr. Erlandson lived and worked in Wheatland until going to Lander in July of 1994.

Mr. Erlandson was born Nov. 21, 1896 in Linderod, Sweden. He was confirmed in the Lutheran Church in 1911 at age 15. He immigrated to the United States in 1914. He made his home with his brother in Albert City, Iowa, until he went to Swedish Hospital in Englewood, Colo., for health reasons. He moved to Wheatland in 1928 where he was a barber for 60 years. At the time of retirement, Mr. Erlandson had the oldest continuous business in Wheatland.

He married Mildred L. Jones July 20, 1938. Al and

Mildred continued to live in Wheatland until they moved to Westward Heights Care Center in Lander for health reasons and to be near their family.

He was a lifelong member of the Odd Fellows Lodge in Wheatland and affiliated with the First Congregational Church in Cheyenne.

Alfred was preceded in death by his parents, four brothers and two sisters. He is survived by his wife, Mildred, and son and daughter-in-law Ed and Peggy Erlandson of Lander; three grandsons and their wives: Gary and Heather Erlandson of Teec Nos Pos, Ariz.; Russell and Athylean Erlandson of Sevierville, Tenn.; Bruce and Anneke Erlandson of Lander; three great-grandchildren.
