

1-31 LUELLA GARRETT 1989

Luella Patrick Garrett died Jan. 31, in Riverside, Cal.

She was born Sept. 4, 1884, in Gault, Ontario, Canada. She and her mother, Dr. Florence Patrick, and brothers, Ben and Tom, came to Wyoming in 1902.

After a summer session at the University of Wyoming, Garrett taught several years in rural schools in the Laramie and Horse Creek Areas.

She then went to Garrett where she taught school and met Robert Garrett. They were married in 1913 and resided on a small ranch in the Garrett community for over 40 years.

In the late 1940's they moved to Wheatland in the winter, spending summers at the ranch.

Mr. Garrett died at the ranch in 1956.

Mrs. Garrett has resided in California with her son, Robert, for the past eight to 10 years.

Surviving are her son, Robert D. Garrett, Cal.; a daughter Marie Atkinson, Laramie; four grandchildren; one great-grandson and numerous nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Feb. 4 in the United Church of Christ with Rev. Virgil Lamm officiating.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
