

GEORGE, VERNA ALICE BRUNDAGE

February 22, 1892-January 20, 1949

Mrs. Verna Alice George of the Slater community died suddenly on January 20 at the home of her sister in Unionville, Mo., where she had been visiting relatives for the past week. She was born at Wier City, Kans. on February 22, 1892 and had been a member of the Slater community for 32 years. She was a member of the Christian church.

Survivors include a son, Robert Lee George of Slater; two sisters, Mrs. Lena Duncan of Lucerne, Mo. and Mrs. W.A. Howard of Unionville, Mo.; three brothers, Virgil Brundage of Lucerne, Lee and Frank Brundage of Brundage, both of Unionville. Her husband preceded her in death in 1944.
