WHEATLAND — Funeral services for Bryan Lee Geringer, 19, will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the United Church of Christ in Wheatland, with the Rev. Ken Saunders officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery. Family and friends may call at the funeral home from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday, and from 9 a.m. to noon Tuesday.

He died Aug. 1, 1998, near Wheatland, due to injuries received in an automobile accident. He was born Feb. 1, 1979, the son of Fred and Jerelyn (Howard) Geringer, in Wheatland.

He was reared and educated in Wheatland, graduating from the Wheatland High School in 1997. In high school, he participated in football, wrestling and Future Farmers of America. He was also active with 4-H for 10 years. He was confirmed into the United Church of Christ in May 1995.

He worked for Geringer Brothers, in farming, until venturing out on his own this past year. He and his cousin, Jason Goertz, had just started a custom harvesting business.

He was a member of the United Church of Christ and Wheatland Beet Growers. He loved the outdoors and agriculture. His family and friends were very important to him.

He is survived by his parents of Wheatland; two sisters, Nicole Albertson and Karen Sue Grant, both of Wheatland; maternal grandparents, Jackie and Cleet Allen of Wheatland; and numerous aunts, uncles, cousins and friends.

He was preceded in death by his paternal grandparents, John and Bertha Geringer; maternal grandfather, A.C. Howard; and three uncles.
