

GERINGER, GOTTLIEB SR.  
March 17, 1878-June 25, 1935

Gottlieb Geringer, prominent farmer of the Wheatland Flats east of here passed away Tuesday morning after an illness of about two weeks. While Mr. Geringer had not been in the best of health for some time, he was not known to be suffering from any ailment and his demise came as a distinct shock to the entire community.

Mr. Geringer was born in Russia March 17, 1878 and was 59 years, 3 months and 8 days of age at the time of his death. He came to the United States in 1908 and settled in the Rocky Ford, Colo., country. In December 1927, he and his family moved to the Wheatland Flats and since that time has made his home here.

Besides his widow, he is survived by five sons, Gottlieb, Jr., Henry, John, Jacob and Albert of Wheatland; four daughters, Mrs. Dave Martin of Wheatland; Mrs. Kathryn Ziler of Brighton, Colo.; Mrs. Elizabeth Drury of Wheatland; and Miss Helen of Wheatland.

Funeral services will be held Friday at 2 from the Bethlehem Evangelical church with Rev. G.T. Zucher in charge of the services. Interment took place in the Wheatland cemetery with the Copley Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
