Geringer, 57, passed away May 24, 2003, at the Marquis Care Center in Boise, Idaho after a courageous battle with lung cancer.

Ron was born in Wheatland, Wyoming on November 27, 1945, to Gottlieb and Edla (Johnson) Geringer, the third of seven children. He grew up on the family farm, was active in 4-H Club and the Lutheran Church youth group. He worked at Bryce Orr's Texaco until he graduated from Wheatland High School in 1964. He was employed in accounting, worked on forest fires and particularly enjoyed working in the hospitality industry as a bartender in Denver Colo., Casper Wyo., Tucson Ariz., Walla Walla Wash. and Boise Idaho.

Ron is survived by this daughter, Julie Mathey, Eugene Ore., his sons Allen Geringer and Andy Geringer, both of Boise Idaho and his former wife, RoxeAnne Crawford of Emmett Idaho. He is
