

GIBBONS, EDITH D'ARCY  
1872-January 26, 1916

Mrs. M.M. Gibbons, whose critical condition was noted in last week's issue of the Times, passed peacefully on her journey to the great beyond, Wednesday afternoon. Funeral services were from the Catholic church on Friday morning. Father Mathias of Douglas administering the last sad rites.

Edith D'Arcy was born in England 44 years ago, but early came to this country. In 1895 she was married to M.M. Gibbons in Denver. To them were born four sons and three daughters, all of whom, with the father, are left to mourn the loss of a faithful wife and mother.
