

GIBBONS, MICHAEL
April 8, 1860-December 19, 1943

Michael Gibbons of Guernsey died at the Neely Convalescent Home in Wheatland, December 19, after a long illness. He was born in Oben, Scotland, April 8, 1860, and was 83 years, 8 months and 11 days at the time of his death.

He was the son of John Gibbons and Mary McIntyre Gibbons of Scotland and came to this country 62 years ago.

Mr. Gibbons at one time had a shoe shop and store in Wheatland, moving to Guernsey in 1933, where he conducted such a business there. He live in and around this community for 38 years.

He leaves to mourn his death seven children, his wife, Edith Darcy, preceding him in death in 1916.

His children are: Mary Iona Vollick of Denver; Anna Courtner, Long Beach; Edith Frigate, Washington State; four sons, Richard of Richmond, Calif.; Joseph of Pittsburg, Calif.; C.A. of Seattle; John of Wilmington, Calif., two sisters, Anna Fetherston of Long Beach and Katie O'Hara of Woodside, Long Island.

The funeral was Thursday morning at the Catholic church with Father Ferdinand presiding. The Copley funeral home was in charge of arrangements.
