

GILMOUR, ROBERT OWEN
September 23, 1942-March 6, 2009

Funeral liturgy for Robert Owen "Bob" Gilmour, 66, was conducted at 10:00 A.M. Tuesday, March 10, 2009 at Saint Patrick Catholic Church in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Father Jan Santich as Celebrant. Interment with military rites accorded by Ora Call American Legion Post #10 and Laramie Peak Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #3558 was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

He died Friday, March 6, 2009, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Bob was born September 23, 1942 in Beloit, Wisconsin, son of William Lloyd and Helen (Pearcy) Gilmour. He was reared and educated in Beloit; graduating from Beloit Memorial High School. Bob joined the United States Air Force November 3, 1961, and retired November 30, 1981. Bob married Donna Lynn Maxted in Beloit on October 19, 1963. In 1979, he and his wife moved to Wheatland where he worked for the Platte County Sheriff's Office and the Wheatland Police Department. He owned and operated Gilmour Heating and Air Conditioning and LeAnn's Liquor Store. Bob loved woodworking, wine making, playing cards and his animals. He raised quarter horses and started the Platte County Horseman's Association.

Survivors include his wife, Donna of Wheatland; a foster daughter, Deborah Lynn Seiloff of Cheyenne, Wyoming; two grandchildren, Elsha and Trey Seiloff of Cheyenne; three brothers, Lloyd (Ruby) Gilmour of Rockford, Illinois, Allen Gilmour of Beloit and Warren (Mary Lou) Gilmour of Camp Douglas, Wisconsin, and a sister, Eleanor (Leroy) Holtz of South Beloit, Illinois.

He was preceded in death by his parents; three brothers, Harold, George and John; and three sisters, Irene, Ida and Blanche.
