

GLDENING, LUCINDA BELL GENTRY

1858-October 27, 1931

Mrs. Lucinda Bell Glendening, one of the earliest residents of Wheatland, passed away at her home in Boulder, Colo., October 27.

Mrs. Glendening, who has made her home in Boulder the past 14 years was 73 years, 1 month and 21 days of age at the time of her death.

Funeral services were held from the Lyla Watson Funeral Home chapel Saturday morning at 10 o'clock and burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery beside her husband who preceded her in death 14 years ago. Cecil V. Smith, pastor of the Christian church, preached the funeral sermon.

The deceased is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Anna Darland, Boulder, Mrs. Addie Near, Grand Junction, Colo., and Mrs. Ida Loughmiller, Hartman, Colo.; two sons, Arthur Glendening of Boulder and Joe Glendening of Portland, Ore.; one step-daughter, Mrs. Rose Gilbert of Plainville, Colo. and one step-son, Chas.
